2010 Summer Health Careers Institute

THE PURPOSE

- To encourage high school students with interests and abilities in math and science to pursue health careers.
- To provide these students with information and experience that will help them make intelligent educational career choices.

During this six-day program students from all over the state will come together to explore various medical health professions as well as have the opportunity to tour health care facilities; discuss career options with professors and health practitioners; and shadow a health professional during the trip to the University of Colorado Denver, Anschutz Medical Campus "job shadow day" in Aurora.

PROGRAM

Health Career Exploration and Education. This program is funded by a grant from The Colorado Trust foundation. The Colorado AHEC System provides room and board, meals and all activities at no expense to the students. Housing is at a local college campus dorm setting (Colorado Christian University) with 24-hour supervision by AHEC staff, counselors and volunteers.
